IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister
by subsection (1) of section 165 of the Penal Code, this Cap. 106.
Order is made this 6th day of January, 1993.

1. This Instrument may be cited as the Penal Code
(Exclusive use of the Red Cross and Red Crescent Emblems)
Order, 1993, and shall come into force on the 1st day of
March, 1993. Title

2. The distinctive marks comprising— Descrip-
tion of
distinctive
marks.
 - (a) the sign of the red cross on a white ground and
the designation "Red Cross"; and
 - (b) the sign of the red crescent on a white ground
and the designation "Red Crescent",
shall be for the exclusive use of the persons specified in the
Schedule to this Order.
